

Top photo schools and universities will select their best students and share their email addresses with Canon by end of May.



Canon will maintain close communication with the students through our online registration management tool so we can book their flights and finalise their accommodation.



Students will prepare their portfolio in a digital format.



Students will bring their own camera.



The final programme will be shared with the students before Visa starts.
