FX	Fail - some work required before the credit can be awarded
F	Fail - considerable further work is required

Quick summary: students are evaluated on a scale from 0 to 20 where 0 is the lowest grade and 20 the highest one. 10 is the medium grade, below 10/20, the course is considered as failed.

The quotations are given as they have been transmitted by each professor or responsible. They have not yet been subject to deliberation and the student has not yet had second chance to repass the subjects (as it is always the case for our students). We leave it to the Partner Institution to deliberate their students but, on specific request, we can organise the results of the Erasmus' students to be deliberated by the IHECS. In this case, the Partner Institution will have to wait for the next sitting of the IHECS.
